

PARTY WEB PAGE – ADDING JAVASCRIPT AND CSS EFFECTS

1. Create a new page for your website called

party.html

You can do this by copying your existing index.html and renaming the file.

Make sure it's called party.html and *not* party.html.txt !

2. Open the page in Notepad or Visual Studio Code and add a “Party Time” header to the page using the h2 tag

3. Somewhere between the <head> tags add in the <link...> tag shown below

```
<head>
  <link rel="stylesheet"
href="https://cdnjs.cloudflare.com/ajax/libs/animate.css/4.1.1/animate
.min.css" />
</head>
```

4. Somewhere after the <body> tag add this

```
<script src="https://cdn.jsdelivr.net/npm/party-
js@latest/bundle/party.min.js"></script>
<script>
document.body.addEventListener("click", function (e) {
  party.confetti(e);
});
document.body.addEventListener("contextmenu", function (e) {
  party.sparkles(e);
});
</script>
```

5. Reload the page and click on the background to see the confetti and then right-click to see the sparkles

6. Open the file again and after the <body> tag find your <h1> tag

```
<h1>
```

Change it to:

```
<h1 class="animate__animated animate__bounceInLeft">
```

Save the file and test it!

7. Try out the different classes for different effects by changing the **red class name** above.

You can find the different classes here: <https://animate.style/>

8. Finally open your index.html and just before the last </body> tag add this then save the file:

```
<a href="party.html">Party Time</a>
```

9. Test your webpage to make sure it's working!
